<p>MLS Monthly bill for June MLS service. It is \$60.</p> <p>It is sent to the Broker Offices for all the licensees in that office. It will be the last monthly billing invoice.</p>	<p>Your broker will get this directly at the end of May.</p>	<p>GJARA or your broker depending on how your office is set up.</p>	<p>Last monthly bill for MLS service, that will be billed to brokers' offices.</p>
<p>First quarterly billing invoice for MLS Services.</p> <p>These bills will be sent to individual licensees at the office address on file at GJARA, NOT TO YOUR HOME.</p>	<p>Early to Mid-June</p>	<p>GJARA or your broker, depending on how your office is set up.</p> <p>If your broker is still going to pay the bill for you and bill you later, you must turn this invoice over to them upon receipt.</p> <p>You may use the GJARA online payment method in LAMPS to pay directly.</p> <p>IT IS YOUR PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY TO ENSURE THIS IS PAID AS THE BROKERS WILL NOT BE RECEIVING A STATEMENT OF ALL THEIR LICENSEES.</p>	<p>This is the beginning of our new quarterly MLS Fees Billing program.</p> <p>With office system changes in the brokerages, the request for individual billing has resulted in the best practice being quarterly billing with delivery of the invoices to the individual subscriber/participant, at their office address on record with GJARA.</p> <p>Non-payment by the 5th of each calendar quarter will result in late fee assessment.</p> <p>Further non-payment will cause disconnection of MLS services, resulting in your listings reverting to the brokers name.</p> <p>Brokers will then be required to turn your license in if the Quarterly MLS is not paid and you pay the reinstatement fees before the 20th, as the entire office will lose its MLS if not.</p>
<p>SUPRA KEY ACCESS billing.</p> <p>Sent to you personally and to the office address on file at GJARA, NOT YOUR HOME.</p>	<p>Early to Mid-June</p>	<p>GJARA</p>	<p>This is your annual supra billing period. Your key is licensed to you for one year from July 1 to June 30.
